Papers should be double-spaced and printed with high quality printers using type style of 11-point or larger. Each copy of the paper should have a cover page containing the title of the paper, names and addresses of the authors, e-mail of one author who is responsible for all correspondence (unless specified otherwise, correspondence will be directed to the first author listed), a list of at least five keywords, and an abstract of no more than 200 words. Five copies of each paper should be sent with a cover letter by airmail to the Secretary of the conference (alternatively, submission can be through e-mail, but must be in LaTeX format).
